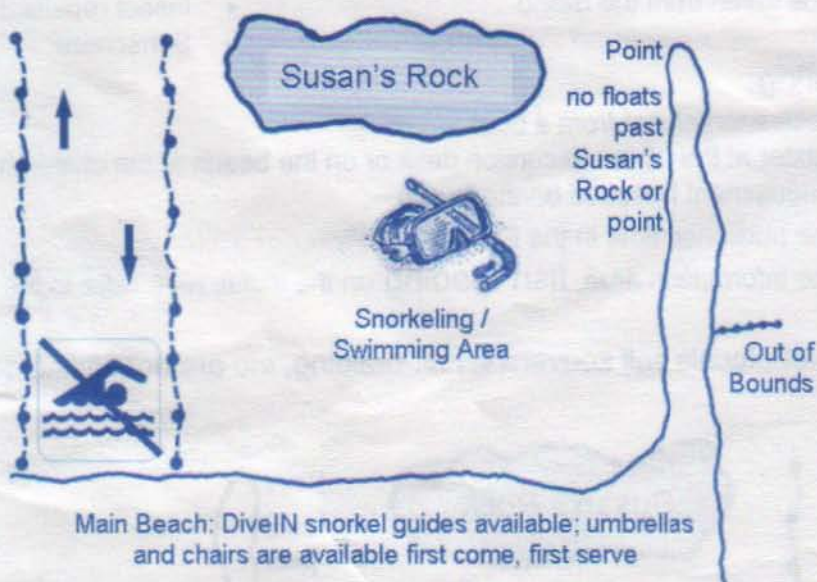


Great Stirrup Cay

Swim or wade around in the sandy shallows to check out the many schools of fish and our artificial reef. Or if conditions permit, swim outside the cove and discover deeper water and coral formations. Your knowledgeable Dive In™ instructors will even snorkel around the cove with you to point out the local marine life during our complimentary guided tours, which depart from the beach hourly.

PARASAIL Level 1, flight time max 7 minutes, boat time about 45 min. Minimum wt.: 60 lbs. Sail 400 feet above the pristine waters of the Bahamas in tandem while being towed by a parasail boat off the beach of Great Stirrup Cay. Parasailing is seasonal and usually available during the summer months only. For parasailing, guests under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian

WATER TOYS

Enjoy a tranquil afternoon floating lazily in Bertram's Cove by raft or float, or try a paddle by paddleboat and peek through the clear water below your vessel to see colorful fish swim by. Please ensure to mind all items, the DiveIn™ staff are not liable for rental items left unattended.

Please Note:

- No swimming or snorkeling in the tender lane.
- Towels and towel collection: you must bring towels from the ship and return them to the ship.
- Lockers: There are no lockers on the island, but all you'll need is your ship id, your towel from the ship and whatever else you need at the beach.
- Shell collection: no shells or animals are to be taken from the island
- If you plan on wearing any mask or snorkel that covers your nose or mouth, even your own, snorkel vests are mandatory in the water; and vests just sign up at the Dive Hut

Free Services at GSC:

What GSC does not have:

- Towels or towel collection: guests must bring and return towels to and from the ship
- Shell collection: no shells or animals are to be taken from the island
- Lockers
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen

Island activities: For everyone: snorkeling:

- Rental is for the morning
- Snorkel instruction
- beach snorkel, not from a boat
- register at the shore excursion desk or on the beach at the dive-in hut
- all equipment is issued on the beach

For adults: yoga: \$11.50 sign up fee, refer to the published time in the Freestyle Daily

For the kids: A scavenger hunt, meets at the information area, fish feeding on the inside reef, refer to the published times in the Freestyle Daily.

Options that require cash: "Straw Market", locals sell souvenirs, hair braiding, etc-are not affiliated with NCL. (Bring small \$ bills 1's 5's 10' 20')
